ASSESSMENT METHODS	Written test. The exam consists in a 50 question multiple choice test. It aims at verifying students' acquisition of the linguistic skills to be acquired at the end of the course. The questions are structured so as to allow students to formulate their answers through the possibility to compare the submitted answers. In order to get the passing grade it is necessary to answer correctly at least 15 questions. When passing the exam, students get the qualification 'idoneità'.
