<b>PREREQUISITES</b>	In order to understand the contents and achieve the learning objectives of the course, the student must have basic knowledge of the main cognitive domains subject to psychological investigation.

<b>ASSESSMENT METHODS</b>	The student's assessment involves an oral examination that aims to assess whether the student has knowledge and understanding of the topics. The evaluation is expressed in thirtieths. An excellent evaluation (grade 30 - 30 and honors) corresponds to an excellent knowledge of the topics dealt with with excellent display skills. A high rating (26-28 rating range) corresponds to a good one mastering the topics, expressed appropriately. A discrete evaluation (range 24-25) corresponds to a basic knowledge of the topics of the program, expressed with a discrete property of language. A satisfactory evaluation (range 21-23) corresponds to a basic knowledge of almost all the topics covered in the program, expressed in a technical language only partially mentioned. A sufficient evaluation (18-20) corresponds to a minimum basic knowledge of the essential topics of the program, expressed in non-technical language. The evaluation is insufficient if the student demonstrates that he does not have adequate knowledge of the basic topics of the program.
<b>EDUCATIONAL OBJECTIVES</b>	The course will provide students with an adequate mastery of theoretical perspectives and of the fields of application of general psychology and basic psychic processes.
