LEARNING OUTCOMES	 Knowledge and understanding Students must demonstrate knowledge and understanding of the literary topics dealt with, and about pedagogie of the litterature. -Autonomy of judgment Students must demonstrate the ability to integrate knowledge and manage complexity, as well as to make judgments about literary texts and pedagogie of the litterature. - Communication skills Students should be able to reflect and communicate on literary topics studied and able to read literally or essay texts in a critical and autonomous way and to teach litterature, in according with the last pedagogich orientations.
ASSESSMENT METHODS	Oral Presentation probably in Spanish + Presentations of short written reports on topics addressed in the classroom and participation in any educational and cultural activities also held outside the University. The evaluation takes place in "30/30" and the final oral exam consists of a colloquium aimed at ensuring the possession of the knowledge and skills provided, the ability to contextualize and abstraction; The exhibition capacity. In order to pass the exam, the student must demonstrate an elemental achievement of the intended objectives. The articulated interview will be divided into 6 questions, each of which will be assigned a score from 0 to 2, corresponding to 0 = just enough; 1 = discrete; 2 = good / great. The objectives are considered elementary / just sufficient when the student demonstrates that they have a basic knowledge of the arguments they are doing, is able to make minimal links between them, shows that they have acquired a limited degree of autonomy, their language is enough to communicate with the examiners, he can make a superficial reading and interpretation of a literary text, his knowledge of the Spanish language is faulty. The objectives are considered discrete when the student demonstrates discrete knowledge of the topics; Is able to make connections with a certain readiness; Has a discreet autonomy of judgment and an average knowledge of the Spanish language and literary language; How to read and understand a literary text. To achieve a score, however, the student / s must demonstrate that he has achieved the objectives well. The goals are considered to be excellent when it has fully understood the topics discussed, it shows how to make relevant and deep links between them, to have acquired a good autonomy of judgment, to know the Spanish language and literary language, to know how to apply The knowledge gained in other contexts, the ability to read and interpret literary text. The final grade of the oral exam will have a weight of 50%, including active participation in lessons an
