LEARNING OUTCOMES	<p>KNOWLEDGE AND UNDERSTANDING: The student must acquire an appropriate knowledge of the main data related to the organization of the Cultural Heritage.</p> <p>ABILITY TO APPLY KNOWLEDGE AND UNDERSTANDING: The knowledge acquired will allow the student to correctly understand some of the problems posed by the concrete reality of work in the field of Cultural Heritage, particularly with regard to the communication aspects. The student will be able to develop satisfactory arguments that combine the theoretical skills already acquired with an understanding of the specific administrative mechanisms of the cultural heritage sector.</p> <p>AUTONOMY OF JUDGEMENT: The student will thus be able to provide a critical and constructive answer to the questions that arise and to elaborate appropriate and historically founded judgments and to apply them both to general and specific cases.</p> <p>COMMUNICATION SKILLS: The student will acquire the fundamental vocabulary of the discipline, will evaluate its historical and theoretical importance so as to be able to compare with specialist interlocutors in a clear and thorough manner.</p> <p>ABILITY TO LEARN: The result of this work will allow the student to deal with the fundamental themes of the discipline in an autonomous and conscious manner, to orient himself directly and autonomously in the texts and to acquire the necessary knowledge to propose further in-depth studies.</p>
ASSESSMENT METHODS	<p>During this workshop, students will meet operators and officials working in the field of Cultural Heritage. The active participation in the workshop allows to acquire 3 cfu, after an oral examination that takes place at the end of the activities. The examination will focus on the topics covered during the lessons and on the review of a short written report that the student provides the same day of the test. The grade is expressed through a judgment (insufficient, sufficient, good, excellent). Attendance at the workshop is compulsory, participants may be absent for no more than 5 hours. The workshop has a limited number of 30 participants.</p> <p>The vote is expressed through a judgment (insufficient, sufficient, good, excellent). The candidate will have to answer three questions about the contents discussed during the workshop. The questions will tend to verify a) the knowledge and understanding acquired; b) the processing skills; c) the possession of adequate exhibition capacity; d) autonomy of judgement.</p> <p>Distribution of votes:</p> <p>- Excellent:</p> <p>a) Advanced knowledge of the subjects and critical understanding of the theories and principles of the discipline b) Advanced ability to apply knowledge and solve proposed problems also in an innovative way c) Full ownership of specific language d) Ability to organise work autonomously and innovatively</p> <p>- Good:</p> <p>a) Comprehensive and specialized knowledge accompanied by critical awareness b) Full ability to apply acquired knowledge and develop creative solutions to abstract problems. c) Good command of specialist language. d) Ability to organise work independently</p> <p>- Sufficient:</p> <p>a) Knowledge of facts, principles, processes and general concepts of the Laboratory b) Basic ability to apply methods, material tools and information related to teaching c) Basic command of specialist language d) Basic ability to organize work autonomously</p> <p>- Insufficient: The student has exceeded the limit of 5 hours of absence allowed. The final paper has not been delivered.</p>
