PREREQUISITES	A basic knowledge of Musical Theory and Music History is required.
LEARNING OUTCOMES	Knowledge of the history of Opera. Comprehension of dramaturgical techniques in musical works. Ability to discuss specific examples of musical theater in relation to musical genres, morphology and historical background. Ability to introduce younger students to the listening of operas.
ASSESSMENT METHODS	Oral exam. The final grade will be from 18/30 to 30/30 cum laude.
EDUCATIONAL OBJECTIVES	The course aims at introducing students to the understanding of musical theater. It will focus on the concept of musical dramaturgy, taking into exam one or more examples of operas, also discussing their historical context. Moreover, some lessons will be dedicated to the teaching of the History of Musical Theater in different educational contexts. In the academic year 2019/2020 the course will focus on Italian Romantico Opera and especially on the works Nabucco, Roberto Devereux, Il Pirata, that will be staged at Teatro Massimo during the season 2020.
TEACHING METHODS	Lectures. Watching or listening to operas. Analysis of musical scores.
