PREREQUISITES	No prerequisites for this course
LEARNING OUTCOMES	Knowledge and Comprehension Knowledge of basic concepts and main theoretical approaches of sociology. Methodology Research: knowledge and comprehension of specificity of scientific method in social sciences, of some main research techniques, in order to enhance student's ability to analyze, comprehend and explain phenomena. Knowledge and comprehension ability applied: The course aims train students' abilities to analyze in social phenomena, to
	compare main sociological approaches, to choose appropriate research techniques between those presented in the course.
	Making judgements: The course aims to train students' making judgement both in social phenomena analysis and in choosing research's paths, techniques, information, data sources, so they understand background issues, also relevant for their future profession.
	Communicative skills: Students are required to achieve the appropriate terminology they can master in order to expose what they learned in the course as well as their own judgements and opinions. It will strengthen their communicative skills.
	Learning skills: Through study of course's topics, in both parts of sociology and research methodology, students will enhance their own ability to analyze social phenomena, to comprehend methodological issues, to in set up and to take part in empirical research. The course aims to enhance student's learning skills through comprehension of main dimensions of scientific method as well as through presenting how information can be found, assessed and used. So, within its duration, the course aims to enhance abilities to know and learn about the society.
ASSESSMENT METHODS	Written and oral exam. Exams will focus on the texts included in the list and on the notes taken in class. 1) Written exam, with 6 open-ended question on first half of course's topics. 2) Students with positive grade can pass an oral exam on second half of course's topics. The oral exam consists of an interview aimed to check the level of knowledge of the topics in the syllabus, the level of familiarity with the specialized language and the to develop a reasoning aimed to the application of theoretical knowledge to specific cases. The interview consists of a minimum of two/three questions. For both exams, grades are out of 30. Final grade is an average of each exam's grade. In itinere exam is the same of written one previously described.
EDUCATIONAL OBJECTIVES	Students will learn basic concepts of sociology and research methodology and will understand how much they are useful for future profession. About research methodology, knowledge to be learned concern scientific method, with reference to social sciences and statistical sciences, as well as main research techniques, in order to enhance abilities to analyze, comprehend and explain social phenomena qualitative and quantitative. Knowledge to be learned also concern main methodological issues in social sciences, knowledge and abilities to comprehend and to use research techniques.
