	dialogue with the examined works shall take place. This bears on the
	assumption of the interrelatedness of history and philosophy. In frontal teaching and seminars the texts are analyzed focusing both on arguments and
	philosophical vocabulary. Active participation is strongly recommended.
	In order to enhance the coordination with other courses, a part of the program will be dedicated to the trans-disciplinary topic "Identity and Conflict".
