PREREQUISITES	Knowledge of Italian legal system and sports legal system
LEARNING OUTCOMES	Knowledge and comprehension ability: full and detailed comprehension of the legal instruments expected. Ability to apply knowledge and comprehension: perfect ability so that the student can apply what he/she studied to the real cases, through connections and examples between the law and the practical cases. Independent judgment: achievement of a high standard of critical judgment is expected. Communication skills: full mastery of the legal language and good communications skills expected. Learning skills: achievement of a high standard so that the student develops a critic way of thinking.
ASSESSMENT METHODS	Oral test. The test verifies the ability to analyze and the knowledge of the topics taught during the course. The student must answer to questions proving knowledge and analyzing with independent judgment as well as using the correct juridical terminology. The range for the final assessment is 18 up to 30. The student who obtains 30 -30 with honors has an excellent knowledge of the topics, excellent use of the terminology and good analytical skills. The student who obtains grades between 26-29 has a good mastery of the topics and a very good use of terminology. The student who obtains grades between 24-25 has a basic knowledge of the main topics and a fair use of terminology. The student who obtains grades between 21-23 has a satisfactory knowledge of the topics and a satisfactory use of the specific terminology. The student who obtains grades between 18 and 20 has a very poor basic knowledge both of the topics and the use of terminology. During the course the students could attend test in itinere, aimed to verify the competence acquired.
EDUCATIONAL OBJECTIVES	The course is intended to give a complete knowledge of the European sports system, with a theoretical and practical approach, in order to form experts in sports management and sports legal practice. The course analyze in depth all the issues of European Sport's Law, with particular regard to the European Court of Justice's jurisprudence on the field of sporting exception
