PREREQUISITES	A good knowledge of the theories and of the acting methods in the history of theatre.
LEARNING OUTCOMES	The student will acquire an advanced knowledge of the Italian and European Nineteenth twentieth centuries theatrical texts with the analysis and the work on the actors' prompt-books. Moreover he will extend his capability to understand developments and forms of the late twentieth-century plays. Each student will obtain a more consciousness of his own capability to criticize, analyze and explore theories and techniques concerning plays and acting methods. Moreover the student will be able to interpret the Italian and English prompt-books which have been signed with the Italian or English declamatory method, and know the application of the Italian declamatory method.
ASSESSMENT METHODS	Final oral exam. Evaluation scale: 30-30 cum laude attests an advanced knowledge; 29-26 attests a proficient knowledge; 25-22 attests a good knowledge; 21-18 attests a basic knowledge.
EDUCATIONAL OBJECTIVES	The Student should be able to examine and discuss forms, theories and applications of the theatrical texts.
TEACHING METHODS	The course includes 15 sessions - all sessions are two hours long, and a practical workshop of readings of the Italian and English prompt-books signed with the declamatory method.
