PREREQUISITES	Basic notions of business administration.
LEARNING OUTCOMES	Knowledge and understanding. This course provides students with knowledge related to the analysis and use of strategic andd management control systems and the main tools of management accounting.
	Applying knowledge and understanding. The course provides Students with a problem solving approach for decision-making processes in management accounting.
	Making judgments autonomy. This course is expected to enhance the Students' capacity to identify and interpret the most significant issues in management accounting that today managers have to deal with to face the business environment.
	Communication skills. This course will allow Students to demonstrate their ability to present their views and develop their dialectical skills.
	Learning ability. This course is expected to develop students' abilities to analyse in-depth academic and professional literature, as well as to translate theoretical knowledge in practice through the observation of different organizational contexts.
ASSESSMENT METHODS	The examination will be a written exam aimed at assessing if the Students acquired the basic notions of the course. The exam will be on all the topics of the course and include open questions, multiple choice questions and exercises. This evaluation system allows to verify the actual achievement of the expected learning outcomes through the assessment of the basic knowledge acquired and of the students' capacity to apply it to concrete cases. The assessment will be expressed in thirtieths. The exam will be considered sufficient when the evaluation is more than 18/30. 18-21: just sufficient; 19-21: sufficient; 22-24: more than sufficient; 25-27: fair; 28-29: good; 30: very good; 30 cum laude: excellent.
EDUCATIONAL OBJECTIVES	The course aims to provide Students with knowledge on the main principles and tools of management control systems and management accounting, coherently with the job opportunities of the Degree course. During the lessons, cases will be presented and exercises will be carried out.
