EDUCATIONAL OBJECTIVES OF THE MODULE

THE MAN MOSES AND MONOTHEISTIC RELIGION. ANTHROPOLOGY OF RELIGION, NARRATIVES AND VISUAL CULTURE

The course focuses on the formation of the philosophy of religion of the father of psychoanalysis and its textual and visual sources. In particular, the background of the writings on Moses, both historical-philosophical and artistic, will be reconstructed. The focus of the lectures will be the various versions of The Man Moses and the Monotheistic Religion and the study on Michelangelo's Moses, which will be an opportunity for a reconstruction of Freud's visual culture.

EDUCATIONAL OBJECTIVES OF THE MODULE		

The course aims at deepening some topics addressed in the general course. In particular, the issue related to the gaze will be focused both from the point of view of the theories of the ancient and recent history of visual culture (Freud; Foucault; Crary; Jay) and, especially, from the point of view of the gender issues related to it. The main theories elaborated within feminist and proto-feminist reflection (Cavendish; Behn; Haywood; Irigaray; Mulvey; Doane) will therefore be treated. Some specific cases in which the "gender view" is staged or questioned will be addressed and the different areas in which it can take place: art; science; the literature (and the post-colonial one).
