ASSESSMENT METHODS The exam consists of an Interim written examination before the official exam date. Samples of exams can be downloaded from the University portal for Abilita' Linguistiche 3 CFU Criteria for assessment: 1.Can write simple sentences and texts explaining some legal concepts = pass 2.Can write detailed sentences and texts on a wide range of legal concepts = pass with merit 3.Can express legal concepts in clear and well-structured points = pass with distinction LEARNING OBJECTIVES (through the 4CS of the CLIL methodological **EDUCATIONAL OBJECTIVES** approach - content, communication, cognition, culture): -Develop contents on contract law -Develop business and legal communication -Develop Business and Legal cognition (remembering, identifying, ordering, defining, comparing and contrasting, dividing, classifying, applying, predicting, hypothesizing, reasoning, thinking creativelly, synthesizing, evaluating) -Develop Legal culture (knowledge of introductory elements of English Contract Law). -Increase confidence in Business-legal skill in English. It consists of lectures and presentations of work prepared by students. Lessons TEACHING METHODS follow a CLIL methodological approach, which integrates language and contents (Content and language Integrated Learning). CLIL is understood as an evolving educational approach to teaching and learning where subjects are taught through the medium of a non-native language; it gives students a different learning experience compared with a conventional foreign language teaching because Business skills and some introduction to contract law and English language are taught together. There will be a mock exam for revision and examination skills (an exam simulation).
