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PREREQUISITES	In order to be able to understand the contents of the course and to achieve the training objectives, the student must have basic knowledge in the field of social psychology (e.g.: categorization, prejudice, social influence) and the methodology of the research (the stages of the research process).	
LEARNING OUTCOMES	Knowledge and comprehension: Knowledge and comprehension of the main theoretical models and methods of the psychology of attitudes.	
	Applying knowledge and understanding: Ability to plan and realize research to analyze attitudes. Ability to interpret social processes using the acquired skills.	
	Making judgements: Ability to work autonomously and forming critical and conscious judgments to deal with events attributable to the psychology of attitudes.	
	Communication: Ability to synthesize, connect and communicate the main contents of the course program using an appropriate psychological lexicon.	
ASSESSMENT METHODS	During the final exam, students will answer 4 or 5 questions. The oral questions may concern any part of the course program, with reference to the recommended books and scientific articles.	
	The candidate obtains the minimum evaluation (18/30) if: a) demonstrates having basic knowledge of the topics covered in the course; b) demonstrates autonomous ability to organize the contents of the discipline; c) demonstrates the ability to apply the contents of the discipline to the professional and socio-cultural context of reference.	
	The vote will be expressed with a metric ranged from1 to 30 and will be recorded during the examination session.	
	The exam will be held in Italian with the possibility of taking it in English for incoming Erasmus students.
