PREREQUISITES	Knowledge of the German language level B2; The student must be able to orient himself in literary terminology e master the main classification tools (literary genres, periodization, etc.).
LEARNING OUTCOMES	Knowledge and understanding To acquire adequate tools for the critical reading of a literary text by identifying the most appropriate methodologies. Ability to apply knowledge and understanding Ability to recognize the textual elements that refer to a more general debate in the cultural, philosophical, theological and social fields of different eras. Autonomy of judgment Being able to recognize and evaluate the positions of the authors and to contrast the opinions of the critics. Communication skills Ability to present the opinions of the critics and the results of the personal observations made. To be in able to support his position. Learning skills Ability to follow, re-using the knowledge acquired during the course, lessons of the same level on other literary and cultural subjects. Ability to keep up-to-date with the offer of new critical tools.
ASSESSMENT METHODS	Learning assessments will tend to verify: a) le acquired knowledge, b) the ability to process, c) the possession of adequate exhibition capacity. The final evaluation of the candidates is expressed in thirtieths and is the result of evaluations obtained during the different learning checks. Rating scale: 30-30 cum laude: excellent knowledge of the subjects, excellent language properties, excellent analytical skills, the student is able to apply the knowledge to solve the proposed problems; 26-29: good command of the subjects, full ownership of language, lo student is able to apply the knowledge to solve the proposed problems; 24-25: basic knowledge of the main topics, good property of language, with limited ability to apply knowledge independently to the solution of the proposed problems; 21-23: the student does not have full mastery of the main subjects teaching but has minimal knowledge; acceptable property of language; limited ability to apply knowledge independently acquired; 18-20: minimum basic knowledge of the topics covered and of the language technical, poor or no ability to independently apply the knowledge acquired; less than 18: the student does not even have a basic knowledge of the contents of the topics covered.
