LEARNING OUTCOMES	Capability to distinguish the work of theatres by productions and theatres by distributions, educational, promotion, fund raising. Capability to use the knowledge acquired. In particular, capability to analyse and judge the notions to be able to settle a further investigation on the subject.

EDUCATIONAL OBJECTIVES	The course will provide to illustrate an extended examples on facts related to the theatre management organisation, specifically to the management organization of Opera Houses. For it will encourage to analyse distinct problems that are linked with the management of Cultural Bodies, by taking into consideration primarily economics and artist requirements in a production organization, and in particular the legislative improvements that govern the Spectacle. It will be explored economics aspects, specifically to the fund raising; legislative and cultural aspects: the so called law 800 and the more recent national rules that has been established in 2011, and in detail it will be studied the transformation of the great Opera Houses, which have been established as Public Bodies, into private Foundations.
TEACHING METHODS	The course includes 15 sessions - all sessions are two hours long, discussion primary reading, seminars and practical workshop on stage directing.
