<b>ASSESSMENT METHODS</b>	<p>Oral examination. aimed at ascertaining the level of knowledge of the subject matters. The exam consists of a minimum of three questions. The evaluation will unfold as follows: Excellent (30 - 30 cum laude): good knowledge of the topics, excellent language skills, excellent capacity of analysis; the student is able to apply theoretical knowledge to real cases which are proposed to be analysed. Very good (26 - 29): good knowledge of the topics, good language skills, good capacity of analysis; the student is able to apply theoretical knowledge to real cases which are proposed to be analysed.
