LEARNING OUTCOMES	<p>Knowledge of the main grammatical patterns of contemporary Italian; Knowledge of the Italian language structures and problems related to their teaching. ASSESSMENT METHODS	<p>Only for students who attend lessons: Written tests (40%) + oral interview (60%) in which will be discussed a written essay For students who don't attend lessons: oral interview (100%) in which will be critically discussed arguments of the subject The written tests consists of semi-structured questions for the analysis of particular structures of the Italian language for the purposes of their teaching. The oral test consists of an interview, in order to check the achievement of skills and knowledge provided by the course. The discussion is based on the case studies examined in the written essay The evaluation is expressed in thirtieths. Description of evaluation methods: 30-30 cum laude: a) very good knowledge of the topics and critical understanding of the theories and the principles of the discipline b) advanced ability to apply the knowledge to analyze the linguistic data c) excellent use of the specific language d) Excellent ability to organize object of study, and to apply the knowledge for linguistic analysis. 26-29: a) Good knowledge of the topics combined with critical ability of analysis b) good ability to apply the knowledge and analyze the linguistic data c) good use of the specific language d) good ability to organize topics autonomously 22- 25: a) basic understanding of the main topics b) limited ability to apply methods and tools to solve the proposed analysis. c) basic knowledge of the specific language d) basic skills to organize the topics of the discipline. 18-21: a) Minimal knowledge of the main teaching topics b) Minimum ability 'to independently apply the knowledge acquired c) low ability to use the specific language of the discipline. d) Minimum ability to organize the topics of the discipline Less than 18:: a) No acceptable knowledge of the contents. b) No ability to argue and analyze the proposed linguistic data. c) No use of the specific language of the discipline The open and semi-structured questions intend to test the results of learning: a) knowledge acquired; b) problem solving ability; adequate ability of argumentation and use a specific language.</p>
