ASSESSMENT METHODS	Intermediate test Students may also take an intermediate test on the program already carried out at the end of the first module (according to the academic calendar). The intermediate test will consist of an oral exam in which students will be asked three questions on the program of the module, with reference to the recommended readings and specially on the L'Età contemporanea. Dalle rivoluzioni settecentesce all'imperliamo, Laterza, by Albero Maria Banti. The evaluation of the intermediate test will concur (50%) to the final assessment. In this case, during the final exam, students will be examined on the program of the second module only, especially on L'Età contemporanea. Dalla Grande Guerra ad oggi, Laterza, by Alberto Maria Banti and one of the recommended volumes. Final oral assessment: The oral assessment is a viva in which knowledge and skills in the field of study are going to be tested. Final notes go from 18 to 30 points. The student is required to answer at least 2 or 3 oral questions regarding the whole program of study with reference to the suggested books.
