LEARNING OUTCOMES	<p>Knowledge and understanding.</p> <p>Knowledge and understanding of the basic concepts of commercial law. Knowledge and understanding of the functioning of firms, individually and collectively; Comprehension about the criteria regulating the decision-making process of the companies.</p> <p>Applying knowledge and understanding.</p> <p>Ability to apply knowledge and understanding by showing a professional approach to work; competences typically demonstrated through devising and sustaining arguments and solving problems within the commercial law.</p> <p>Making judgements.</p> <p>Ability to analyse and evaluate from a juridical standpoint the topics referring to the activity and the organizational asset of enterprises on the basis of the knowledge and methodology learned during the course. Ability to express autonomous judgement.</p> <p>Communication skills</p> <p>Ability to communicate information, ideas, problems and solutions to both specialist and non-specialist audiences</p> <p>Learning skills.</p> <p>Development of learning skills to undertake further studies with a high degree of autonomy. Ability to select instruments and methods to update and constantly improve skills, in particular by analysing case law and law materials as well as referring to specialized literature in the legal field.</p>
ASSESSMENT METHODS	<p>Written test</p> <p>An intermediate written test is scheduled. The candidate is evaluated according to the level of his knowledge and receives an assessment out of thirty as midterm grade (the pass mark is 18/30).</p> <p>This test is not mandatory. Only if the student chooses to take the mid-term test, the mark of the latter will affect the final grade, which will be stated and communicated to the student at the end of the oral exam.</p> <p>Oral exam</p> <p>The candidate should answer at least two/three questions regarding the whole syllabus with the exception of the topics covered by the intermediate test. The final assessment aims to value whether the student has acquired the knowledge and the ability to comprehend the topics dealt with during the lessons. The student should also be able to interpret relevant data and to show competence in giving autonomous judgments.</p> <p>Students will pass the final exam if they show knowledge and understanding of the topics in general terms and have minimal application skills to solve concrete cases. The candidate should also be able to communicate his/her knowledge of the topics to the examiner clearly and appropriately.</p> <p>Below this level the assessment will be not sufficient. The candidate is evaluated according to the level of his knowledge and receives an assessment out of thirty (the pass mark is 18/30).</p> <p>The final grade will take into account the marks of the intermediate test eventually passed by the student; in more detail, the final grade will be determined considering the mathematical average of the marks obtained in written and oral tests.</p> <p>Compensatory tools and dispensatory measures will be guaranteed by the Disability and Neurodiversity Center - University of Palermo (Ce.N.Dis.) to students with disabilities and neurodiversity, based on specific needs and in implementation of current legislation</p>
EDUCATIONAL OBJECTIVES	The course aims to teach the basic concepts of commercial law. At the end of the course, students will acquire general knowledge on firm and corporate law and insolvency proceedings. They will be able to constantly update their knowledge by consulting law, institutional web sites and electronic data bases. Particular attention will be paid to the protection of innovation (e.g. patents, copyright, designs) and to the innovative aspects of corporate law (e.g. digitalisation, environmental and social sustainability).
