RISULTATI DI APPRENDIMENTO ATTESI	<p>Knowledge and understanding</p> <p>Extensive knowledge and understanding of the most relevant concepts concerning the EU competition law. Knowledge and understanding of the economic and juridical principles regulating the EU competition.</p> <p>Applying knowledge and understanding</p> <p>Ability to apply knowledge and understanding by showing a professional approach to work; competences typically demonstrated through devising and sustaining arguments and solving problems within the European competition law.</p> <p>Making judgements</p> <p>Ability to make analysis and juridical evaluation of the topics related to anticompetitive agreements, abuses of dominant position and mergers on the basis of the knowledge and methodology learned during the course. Ability to express autonomous judgement.</p> <p>Communication skills</p> <p>Ability to communicate information, ideas, problems and solutions to both specialist and non-specialist audiences.</p> <p>Learning skills</p> <p>Development of learning skills to undertake further studies with a high degree of autonomy. Ability to select instruments and methods to update and constantly improve skills, in particular by analysing case law and law materials as well as referring to specialized literature in the legal field</p>
VALUTAZIONE DELL'APPRENDIMENTO	<p>Written tests</p> <p>Two intermediate written tests are scheduled. The candidate is evaluated according to the level of his knowledge and receives an assessment out of thirty (the pass mark is 18/30). These tests are not mandatory. Only if the student chooses to take the intermediate tests, the mark of the latter will affect the final grade, which will be stated and communicated to the student at the end of the oral exam.</p> <p>Final oral exam</p> <p>The candidate should answer at least two/three questions regarding the whole syllabus with the exception of the topics covered by the intermediate tests. The final assessment aims to value whether the student has acquired the knowledge and the ability to comprehend the topics dealt with during the lessons. The student should also be able to interpret relevant data and to show competence in giving autonomous judgments.</p> <p>Students will pass the final exam if they show knowledge and understanding of the topics in general terms and have minimal application skills to solve concrete cases. The candidate should also be able to communicate his/her knowledge of the topics to the examiner clearly and appropriately. Below this level the assessment will be not sufficient.</p> <p>The candidate is evaluated according to the level of his knowledge and receives an assessment out of thirty (the pass mark is 18/30). The final mark will take into account the marks of the intermediate tests eventually passed by the student; in more detail, the final grade will be determined considering the mathematical average of the marks obtained in all written and oral tests.</p>
OBIETTIVI FORMATIVI	The course aims to provide advanced knowledge in the field of EU competition law. Furthermore, lessons provide students with the ability to select instruments and methods in order to update and constantly improve learning skills, in particular by analysing case law and law materials as well as referring to specialized literature in the legal field.
