## 14253 - PLANNING AND CONTROL SYSTEMS

Student learning assessment is based on: (1) a written exam, (2) the development and presentation of a project. A mid-term examination is also expected.  (1) A two-hours written examination is to ensure the acquisition of skills, abilities and skills required. The written exam consists in the analysis of a case study developed by each student at the end of the course.  (2) During the semester students - divided into groups of up to three units and supported by professors - will develop a project based on a real public organization. In particular, it is asked to develop a simulation model to explore organizational performance from the perspective of the Dynamic Performance  Management. At the end of the semester, the model developed is presented and evaluated by the professors.  Evaluation criteria (up to 30)  - Excellent: 30-30 laude = very good knowledge of the topics, excellent communication skills language, good analytical ability, the student is able to apply knowledge to solve proposed problems  - Very good: 26-29 = Good knowledge of the subjects, very good communication skills, the student is able to apply knowledge to solve problems proposed  - Good: 24 - 25 = basic knowledge of the main topics, good communication skills, with limited ability to independently apply knowledge to solve the proposed problems  - More than sufficient: 21-23 = limited knowledge of the main topics, basic communication skills, poor ability to independently apply the knowledge acquired - Sufficient: 18-20 = minimum basic knowledge of the main topics, very little or no ability to independently apply the knowledge acquired  - Insufficient = the student does not have an acceptable knowledge
of the contents of the topics covered in the course
