VALUTAZIONE DELL'APPRENDIMENTO	<p>Student learning assessment is based on: (1) a written exam, (2) the development and presentation of a project. A mid-term examination is also expected.</p> <p>(1) A two-hours written examination is to ensure the acquisition of skills, abilities and skills required. The written exam consists in the analysis of a case study developed by each student at the end of the course.</p> <p>(2) During the semester students - divided into groups of up to three units and supported by professors - will develop a project based on a real public organization. In particular, it is asked to develop a simulation model to explore organizational performance from the perspective of the Dynamic Performance Management. At the end of the semester, the model developed is presented and evaluated by the professors.</p> <p>Evaluation criteria (up to 30)</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">- Excellent: 30-30 laude = very good knowledge of the topics, excellent communication skills language, good analytical ability, the student is able to apply knowledge to solve proposed problems- Very good: 26-29 = Good knowledge of the subjects, very good communication skills, the student is able to apply knowledge to solve problems proposed- Good: 24 - 25 = basic knowledge of the main topics, good communication skills, with limited ability to independently apply knowledge to solve the proposed problems- More than sufficient: 21-23 = limited knowledge of the main topics, basic communication skills, poor ability to independently apply the knowledge acquired- Sufficient: 18-20 = minimum basic knowledge of the main topics, very little or no ability to independently apply the knowledge acquired- Insufficient = the student does not have an acceptable knowledge of the contents of the topics covered in the course
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
